Any new registrations received, or weeks added, beyond June 13 will be charged at the increased rate and will be on a space available basis only. Save money and register early!

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SUMMARY: 7-Week Summer Program is open to participants entering Grades 1-8 and limited to ages 6-14. Residents and non-residents may attend. Additional fees apply for non-residents. Program Dates: Monday through Friday, June 20 through August 5. (No program July 4th). Hours are 8:00 AM to 3:45 PM*. Program locations include Timberlane Learning Center (Formerly Sandown Central School); Ed Garvey Recreation Facility; Seeley Beach; Town Hall. Check Parent Guide for location information and daily drop-off. All field trip dates are subject to change, particularly if weather dependent. We reserve right to switch FT in the interest and safety of campers. Parents are responsible for reading and initialing Parent Guide reviewed. ***Afternoon Pick-Up BEGINS at 3:45 PM and late fee applies if camper is not picked-up by no later than 4:00 PM. \$10 for every 15 minutes or portion thereof after 4PM.** There is no transportation provided.

RATES: Rates are by the week only. There are no partial week or daily rates. Attendance is never mandatory! Residents: \$105/wk per camper and includes field trips*. Non-resident: \$110/wk per camper includes field trips*. 3rd and additional children from same immediate family and living in Sandown at same physical address as other children in family pay \$65 per week per camper if ALL attend in the same week(s). Includes field trip*. **Reduced rate applies to Sandown residents only.** A one-time non-refundable registration fee of \$15 per resident camper and \$20 per non-resident camper is paid at registration and includes program tee shirt. *Canobie Lake Park and Water Country incur an additional fee each of \$15 per camper. Note: If you do not include payment for Water Country or Canobie you will not be guaranteed a spot should you change your mind later. There are no refunds for any field trips with the exception of the additional \$15 fee for Canobie Lake Park and Water Country. Read Parent Guide for all policies regarding refunds, late fees, deadlines. There are no alternative program arrangements for campers who do not attend field trips.

PAYMENTS: When you register you will be paying the following: Resident: \$15 registration fee; \$105 per week per child X's the number of weeks your child will attend. Non-residents will pay at registration: \$20 registration fee; \$110 per week per child X's the number of weeks your child will attend. Any registrations for Weeks 2 & 6 will pay additional per week fee of \$15 for field trips to Canobie Lake Park & Water Country. (all rates increase beginning June 14th)

What if you can't pay all at once? At registration you may choose to pay your registration fee along with your first week of camp and place a non-refundable deposit of \$10 per week per child on any additional weeks you wish to register for. **ALL FEES must be paid by no later than JUNE 13th. Beginning Tuesday, June 14th, any week for which you have paid a non-refundable deposit but not the balance, will be released and deposit forfeited.**

Beginning June 14th weekly rates increase by \$10 per week per camper. New registrations beginning June 14th will pay registration fee of \$20 per child and \$115 per week per child rate for resident. Non-residents pay \$25 registration fee and \$120 per week per camper. **Please have all payments in by no later than Monday, June 13th to avoid increase.** We cannot make exceptions. Payment is by check or money order only made payable to: Sandown Recreation. We are not able to process credit card payments. **Cash is NOT accepted.** We are happy to provide receipts for reimbursement from your dependent care flex spending account if needed. **PLEASE READ PARENT GUIDE.** Registration form requires that you acknowledge and sign that you have reviewed all policies in the Parent Guide.

REGISTRATION: All first time registrations must be done in person only. Birth certificate must be provided. Proof- of-residency and photo ID required for first time parent/guardian registering child. Sandown Recreation reserves the right to request proof-of-residency from any participant during the program. Penalties and dismissal from program will apply for anyone claiming false residency, no refund. Participants must reside in Sandown full-time to meet residency requirement. **REGISTRATION FOR PREVIOUS PARTICIPANTS:** You do not need to register in person however you must first call the recreation office prior to sending in any registration. We need to look at space availability for you, and make sure you know the correct fees before you send it in order to avoid errors. Help us to help you get the weeks you want and avoid paying increased rates! Registrations sent without first speaking to recreation director may be returned. Avoid missing the week you want. Call the office at 887-1872 or email us at: recreation@sandown.us prior to sending your registration! The recreation office is not responsible for payments sent through the mail that arrive late. Please leave plenty of time!. There is a drop-box at the recreation building available 24/7. We try to make this as easy as possible for you. Please take advantage of reduced rates and get your registration in as soon as possible.

MORE: For all information on program; procedures; drop-off/pick-up; what your child should bring and not bring; behavior policy; emergency information and more, please review the Parent Guide. On the registration form you will be signing off that you have reviewed the Parent Guide and are familiar with how the program works. This includes former participants. Please ask if you have questions or are unsure about any information. We want your child to have a wonderful program experience within a structured day filled with fun, safety, physical activity, and positive role modeling. We look forward to having your child participate. Please speak with the director regarding any special circumstances your child may have. Please note that for children who require 1:1 assistance or aide in school, the parent/guardian will need to provide their own aide. Please speak with the director regarding anything we should be aware of so that we may help insure that your child's needs can be met for a successful program experience. All information is confidential and HIPA protected. All staff members are Town of Sandown employees, undergo background checks, training, and are First Aid and CPR certified.
